



General Job Description
Position: Kids Club Coach

Affirming God-given value. Multiplying Possibilities.

Kids Club Coaches minister to elementary-aged children who participate in Kids Club afterschool program hosted at Kids Club Main Campus and participating Comal ISD campuses. Coaches help supervise and interact with kids in a fun and appropriate manner. Coaches participate in recreational and educational activities such as games, songs, group homework tutoring, reading, teaching PowerHouse lessons, and leadership development. Coaches perform other duties as directed by the Kids Club Director and program staff.

The Kids Club Coach exemplifies Christlike character in both personal and professional life, upholding Biblical values in attitude, speech, conduct, and lifestyle. S/he leads and serves as a minister of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Maintain a safe, clean, and overall fun experience for the children
- Support all sanitization and health safety protocols
- Work as part of a professional team
- Greet all Kids Club guests and ensure the security of doors, gates, and grounds.
- Assist with pick-up to ensure that children leave with the authorized person
- Interact with the children in a positive and age-appropriate manner
- Organize and participate in recreational and educational activities
- Encourage children's emotional and social development by reinforcing positive behavior
- Encourage understanding of others and supporting positive self-concepts and biblical teaching
- Organize and store games, equipment, and materials
- Attend weekly Coach meetings as well as all monthly staff meetings/trainings as directed
- Participate in and complete assigned tasks in Leadership Development
- Be on time and prepared to work, participating or engaging at all times
- Be available Monday-Thursday per your work schedule

- Conduct oneself in a calm and professional demeanor
- Filter information as confidential, reportable, or necessary for communication according to federal law and NBCM
- Work well with a diverse group of staff, volunteers, and students
- Work productively in an unstructured environment with frequent interruptions

- Weekly coach meeting
- Must be available for special events and trainings
